**Meeting Objectives:**

The purpose of Planning Team Meeting #10 was to follow-up discussion from PT meetings #8 and #9, where discussed mobility, and public spaces and amenities, respectively. This meeting focused on providing the updated mobility framework based on feedback from PT #8. The group confirmed public space and amenities priority maps and finished discussion on the remaining mixed-used corridors and focus areas. Lastly, the Planning Team was provided an update on the VIA UDC amendments.

**Meeting Format**

The meeting was formatted as an open discussion. During the presentation, attendees were encouraged to provide feedback and recommend edits as needed. The meeting also included group discussion around oversized print outs of maps of recommended mobility and amenities' priorities and improvements.


**Mobility Presentation**

The presentation began with staff and planning team introductions and an overview of the Southeast plan process and a brief recap from Planning Meeting #8, Mobility Part 1. Hannah Santiago then presented an overview of the mobility framework, which maps areas of that need improvements or need to be significantly redeveloped for pedestrians and public transit, bicycles and micromobility, and cars and freights vehicles. The planning team was asked to gather around the printed mobility framework map, confirm all corridors identified as key linkages, and prioritize which corridors are in need of more attention. Corridors that received the highest prioritization were Sinclair Road and where it intersects with W.W. White; Highway 87, specifically east of Loop 410; W.W. White Road and where it intersects with Highway 87; and Hackberry Street. Other corridors that received prioritization were the extension of Salado Creek trail and the creation of the Rosillo Creek Trail.

Once the team completed the mobility discussion, the group began discussion on public space and amenities. The group confirmed mapped amenities for the focus areas and corridor discussed at the

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previous planning team meeting. These areas included Pasadena Heights, Lakeside area, Pecan Valley Golf Course, and W.W. White corridor. The team then analyzed the Rigsby Avenue corridor from Comanche Park to Rosillo Creek and the Southcross focus area and determined what public amenities would be appropriate. For Rigsby, the team recommended improved lighting and streetscape, and the inclusion of mobility hubs where Rigsby intersects with Salado Creek, W.W. White, and Rosillo Creek. Bexar County operated Comanche and Covington Parks need to be reactivated, better visibility, and better connection to the corridor. For the Southcross focus area, the team recommended a mobility hub for the W.W. White Road and Southcross intersection. The proposed land use for the focus area is urban mixed and the planning team felt this area was suitable for entertainment, dining, and retail. This area could include more public space such as a plaza, park, or amphitheater along the Rosillo Creek. Additionally, this area should incorporate more connections to the street and provide shops closer to the street and parking in the rear.



**NEXT STEPS:** Planning staff will analyze the discussion and exercise results as well as provide updates to the planning team.
